




- 1 Cut out A1 by cutting along the lines.
- ★ Cut along the line marked ———




2 Cut out the parts to be removed on A1 and A2, and glue together.

- ★ Using the photo as a guide, move your fingers in the direction of the arrow, adjusting the pressure to curl the paper.














- 1 Make a mountain fold and valley fold on B1.
- ★ Trace along the mountain fold line and valley fold line with a stencil pen, scoring it to make it easier to fold.







2 Assemble B1 and B2, and attach them together. Next, attach B2 to B3.
